TRUNK OR TREAT VENDOR REGISTRATION FORM

Friday, October 29, 2021 - 5-8 pm

Spencer Adams Parking Lot (Located on W. Victoria St. between Chapala & Victoria St.)

Vehicle owners do NOT need to come in costume (although strongly encouraged). ALL vehicles will be required to be decorated in age appropriate (2-14 years) themes. MASKS ARE REQUIRED FOR VENDORS.

First, Second and Third Place awards will be awarded at the end of the night.

EVENT OVERVIEW:

Mandatory pre-registration will be required for all participating vendors (Trunkers). Trunkers will be asked to decorate their vehicle trunk, tailgate, or hatchback in a Halloween theme of their choice and provide individually wrapped candy/treats to Treaters (children). We are estimating 350 guests and will be operating in groups of 20-25 people every 10 minutes.

RULES:

- Registration is free for this event; however, all registrations are due by 5pm on Thursday, October 22.
- All vendors must provide their OWN commercially pre-packaged candy or treats for distribution, you may also add your organization's pamphlets.
- Masks and gloves are required at all times; Santa Barbara PAL will have additional PPE if needed.
- Maintain social distancing between different households, no more than 4 people per truck.
- Due to COVID-19 you will not be able to have any games or activities. Be creative with socially distant ways of distributing candy.
- Please be courteous to your trunk neighbors and keep your decorations confined to your parking space. You will have 25 feet or more apart from each trunk.
- No amplified music OTHER THAN Halloween or trunk themed music (no profanity or vulgar language).
- NO electricity will be provided for Trunkers.
- Selling is prohibited at this event.
- ALL trunks and their owners will be photographed.
- Vehicles must arrive NO LATER than 4:30pm and be decorated and ready to go by 5:00pm for opening.
- People's Choice judging will take place until 7:45pm and will be announced no later than 8:15pm.
- Vehicles will not be permitted to move or leave the parking lot until the conclusion of the event, approximately 8:30pm.
- All vehicles will be assigned an entry number at check-in, a health screening will be conducted before entry.
- All those participating must be free of Covid-19, related symptoms and exposures.
- Entry numbers must be placed on the right upper most visible location to ensure People's Choice voters can identify vehicle.

It is further understood and agreed that this waiver, release, and assumption of risk is to be binding on my heirs and assignees, and the heirs. I agree to assume all responsibility for any property damage or injury to any person caused by me while participating in the Santa Barbara Police Activities League, program and/or activity. I acknowledge that my participation in this event could involve risk of physical injury or damage to property. I expressly assume such risk and release and waive any claims against the City of Santa Barbara, its agents, and employees for any injuries to persons or damage to property.
