EVENT OVERVIEW: Pre-registration is a must: Every vendor (Trunker) who wants to join must sign up before the event. Get Spooky: Trunkers, we want you to decorate your vehicle trunk, tailgate, or hatchback with a Halloween theme. Make it fun! Candy Time: Don't forget to bring individually wrapped candies or treats for the kids (Treaters) to enjoy. Group Action: We'll have groups of 30-35 people entering every 10 minutes, so be ready to share your treats. Contest Fun (Optional): If you're up for some friendly competition, you can join the Trunk Contest. We'll announce the First, Second, and Third Place winners at the end of the event. Let's make this Halloween event a spooktacular success!

RULES:

- Registration is free for this event; however, all registrations are due by 5pm on Monday October 16th.
- All vendors **must provide their OWN** commercially pre-packaged candy or treats for distribution, you may also add your organization's pamphlets, enough for 800-1,000 guests.
- Please have no more than 5 volunteers at your trunk.
- Please be courteous to your trunk neighbors and keep your decorations confined to your parking space. You will have 25 feet or more apart from each trunk.
- No amplified music OTHER THAN Halloween or trunk-themed music (no profanity or vulgar language).
- No electricity will be provided for Trunkers.
- No hay bales, glitter, confetti, or silly string is permitted.
- Selling is prohibited at this event.
- Vehicles can arrive as of 3pm and arrive NO LATER than 4pm and be decorated and ready to go by 4:30 pm for opening. Cleanup and takedown will be from 8-8:30pm.
- People's Choice judging will take place until 7:45 pm and will be announced no later than 8pm.
- Vehicles will not be permitted to move or leave the parking lot until the conclusion of the event, approximately 8:30pm.
- All vehicles will be assigned an entry number at check-in.
- Entry numbers must be placed on the right uppermost visible location to ensure People's Choice voters can identify vehicles.
