Maribel Franco was a daughter, sister, friend, and mentor. As a UCSB graduate and a graduate student at Cal State Long Beach, Maribel's dream was to attend college and find a way to give back to those who were disadvantaged due to socioeconomic factors. In the spring of 2014, the Santa Barbara Police Activities League first met Maribel as a tutor with Cal-SOAP. Maribel quickly distinguished herself as a person students could turn to for academic help, advice, and for a positive outlook on life. Education, school, and community involvement were essential to Maribel and she encouraged everyone she met to strive for the best. In the two and a half years Maribel was with SBPAL, her positive impact on the lives of Santa Barbara teens was immeasurable. Unfortunately, Maribel's life was tragically cut short by a drunk driver in October 2016. Her passion for life and commitment to serving others continues to live on in those whose paths she crossed.

This memorial scholarship reflects the traits Maribel exhibited. Maribel was committed and attentive to all she knew. All that knew her felt her positive influence. Her smile was infectious and remains with all of us today. Maribel's life is a reminder that no matter what the circumstances or obstacles, one person can make a positive impact and difference.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants must be SBPAL alumni who graduated high school in the last six years (c/o 2018).
- Applicants must be currently attending a state or nationally-accredited two or four-year college/university (undergraduate studies) or a trade/vocational school.
- Applicants must submit one letter of recommendation: from a teacher, mentor, supervisor or community leader. *SBPAL staff and the SBPAL Board of Directors may not submit a letter of recommendation.*
 - *Letters of recommendation MUST be recent (within the past year), no exceptions.*
- Applicants must provide a copy of an unofficial college transcript – *GPA will not be a determining factor, transcripts will be used to identify academic trends throughout your college career.*

APPLICATION INFORMATION

1. **SELECTION PROCESS** - Applications will be reviewed by the Maribel Franco Scholarship committee, including members of the Franco family. Recipients will be awarded based on the following criteria:
 - Demonstration of commitment and desire to have a positive influence in their school and/or community.
 - Demonstration of leadership skills in school and/or community.
2. **THE ESSAY** – The essay must be typed in MLA format and be between **1,000-1,200** words. All pages must include your name, address, word count, and telephone number in the header. Please **answer all** of the following questions:
 1. Tell us about yourself: Your year, major, favorite/most fulfilling class.
 2. What are your college/career goals? What or who has influenced or inspired these goals?
 3. How are you continuing to make an impact in your community/school?
 - a. Have you had any internships or participated in any volunteer work?
 4. How has college impacted your life?
 5. What does this scholarship mean to you and your college career?
 - a. Is there anything else you would like us to know about you?
3. **IMPORTANT DATES** - Applications and all supporting materials must be completed, and postmarked by **February 23, 2024**. Any incomplete or late applications will not be accepted. Scholarship recipients will be notified by **March 11, 2024 email or phone call**. An Award Ceremony will be held on **March 23rd or 24th, 2024**
4. **PUBLICITY** - By applying, recipients agree to have their name and photo published on SBPAL platforms such as newsletters, signs, websites, affiliated websites, social media, and news releases announcing the results at SBPAL’s discretion.
